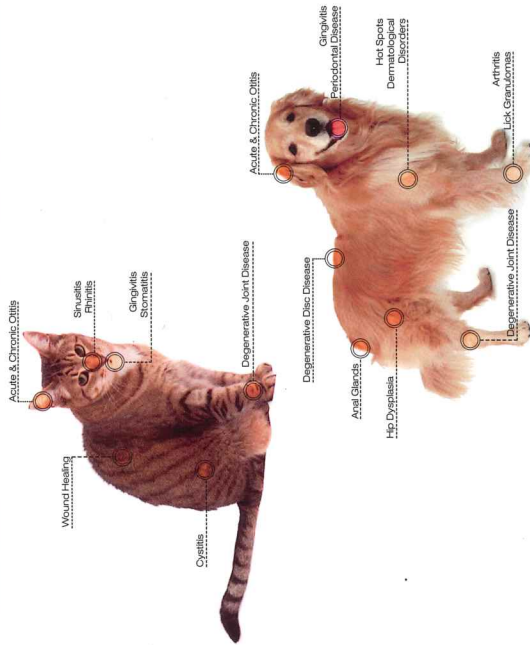

A surgery-free, drug-free, noninvasive treatment to:

- Reduce Pain
- Reduce Inflammation
- Speed Healing



Class IV Deep Tissue Laser Therapy

uses a beam of laser light to deeply **penetrate** **tissue** without damaging it.

Laser energy induces a biological response in the

cells called "photobiomodulation", which leads to **reduced pain, reduced inflammation, and increased healing speed.**

What are the Costs?
