ADVANCED PERIODONTITIS

You will notice severe bad breath, and your pet may be exhibiting signs of pain – including being head shy or dropping kibble while chewing.



MODERATE PERIODONTITIS

You may notice very bad breath, large build-up of tartar especially on molars, very stained or discoloured teeth, and very red gums. Your pet may chew more on one side of its mouth.



EARLY PERIODONTITIS

You may notice stronger smelling breath, more teeth that are discoloured and have tartar build-up as well as red gums.



GINGIVITIS ONLY


You may notice bad breath, tartar build-up on teeth and some reddening of gums.



RECOGNIZING THE SIGNS OF AGING

Cats are masters of disguise and it's often difficult to tell when they are in pain or experiencing the onset of age-related medical issues. Look for changes in the following:

Drinking Urination **Appetite** Weight ☐ Hair Coat (Itchy, dandruff, dull, hair loss, matting) ■ Body Odors (Bad breath, odor from ears or skin) **■** Mobility (Lameness, trouble with stairs, stiffness, pain, spending more time lying down) □ Breathing (Coughing, shortness of breath, wheezing, exercise intolerance, mouth breathing) □ Digestion (Vomiting, diarrhea, constipation, hairballs) □ Senses (Hearing, smelling or vision loss) ☐ Behavior (Reduced family interaction, increased vocalization, loss of litter training) ☐ Growths (New growths, changes in previous growths)



Watch for changes in your cat and speak to your veterinary team. Schedule regular physical examinations that include wellness blood and urine tests to help identify less obvious signs of aging. Your veterinarian may run some diagnostic tests to see if your cat is at risk of, or is suffering from, chronic kidney disease even before there are any visible symptoms.



WE RECOMMEND AT LEAST A SEVEN-DAY TRANSITION WHEN STARTING A NEW DIET.

Cats may reject a new food if it is not introduced slowly by transitioning over a period of 7-10 days. To effectively transition your pet to a new formula, we suggest slowly mixing the new food in with the existing food in gradually increasing amounts.
